Directions to LeAnna Graham's home 326 Imperial Bend, Katy, 77493 (in Remington Trails subdivision)

From Katy:

Go west on Hwy 90 to FM 2855.

Turn right on 2855

Turn right on Remington Park (first entrance to Remington Trails.)

Turn right on Remington Trails Dr.

Continue on Remington Trails Dr. until it ends at Winding Canyon.

Turn left on Winding Canyon

Take first right on to Imperial Bend.

As soon as you turn, LeAnna's house is on the left corner – (2 story house with a barn at the end of the driveway.)

From Cypress:

Take US-290 N toTX-99 (Grand Parkway S).

Merge onto I-10 W

Exit #737 - Pederson Rd.

Turn right on Pederson Rd.

Turn left on Hwy Blvd - US-90W

Turn right onto FM-2855. (Immediate first right turn)

Turn right on Remington Park.

Then follow directions above from Remington Park.
