OWENS ES, CROSSBRIDGE CHURCH ESTABLISH ADOPT-A-SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP

Owens Elementary School and Crossbridge Christian Church representatives met virtually Oct. 12, coming together as the campus and community partner officially announced that they are entering into an Adopt-a-School partnership.

CFISD's Adopt-a-School program pairs schools and community and business partners to utilize resources of the community to strengthen and enrich the quality of education for students.

"We're thrilled, especially now with teachers facing even more difficulties," Frank said. "Any support that we can give them will help because they work so hard."

The partnership makes sense for Crossbridge, which is located less than two miles from the Owens. And while the two are officially partners, the church and school have worked together for years. Recently, Children's Ministry Director Cassandra Gaddis spearheaded a drive to collect and distribute 50 backpacks filled with school supplies.

"We've done teacher appreciation events, staff appreciation and other things like that," said Senior Pastor Kevin Pigg, who is among church staff and members serving as mentors at Owens. "So we've had the relationship for a couple years doing things for the school, so we just decided to make it official."

The partners are already talking about another project to benefit the Owens students and staff. The campus houses an outdoor garden with a patio area classes use for outdoor learning, and plans are in place to raise funds to build a pavilion to provide shade.

ANSWER TO BRAIN TEASER:

This is possible, and there are two ways to do it:

Solution 1: Fill the 3 cup container and pour it into the 5 cup container. Fill the 3 cup container again and pour it into the 5 cup container until the 5 cup container is full. That will leave exactly 1 cup of sugar in the 3 cup container. Dump out the 5 cup container and dump the 1 cup from the 3 cup container into the empty 5 cup container. This leaves 1 cup in the 5 cup container. Now fill the 3 cup container again and add it to the 5 cup container. Now you have exactly 4 cups of sugar in the 5 cup container.

Solution 2: Fill the 5 cup container. Pour it into the 3 cup container until it is full. This leaves 2 cups in the 5 cup container. Dump out the 3 cup container. Now pour the 2 cups from the 5 cup container into the 3 cup container. Refill the 5 cup. Now pour the 5 cup into the 3 cup until the 3 cup is full. That will leave exactly 4 cups of sugar in the 5 cup bucket.

(Then sit down, take a deep breath and ask yourself, "Now what was it that I was trying to bake, anyway?")
