You can apply for a "Project Stipend" from ASTEF (Alpha State Texas Educational Foundation) and receive MONEY! ASTEF provides stipends to individual DKG members, chapters, coordinating councils, and areas in Texas for projects that support the professional and personal growth of women educators in Texas and promote educational excellence for Texas students. Examples of projects which received stipends last year included providing classroom supplies for beginning teachers to encourage and support them; providing books for school libraries; providing bookshelves for youth center afterschool program; creating and donating supplies for school garden; providing foods for students who need meals on the weekends at home. A teacher can apply for funds for materials or specific teaching kit or supplies for her own classroom. The list goes on! Forms for applying for a Project Stipend are on the ASTEF website <a href="www.astef.org/forms">www.astef.org/forms</a>. It's easy! You can receive the funds for your special project!! Recipients of Project Stipends are required to submit a Mid-Year Report, End-of-Year Report, and a project display for exhibit at the TSO Convention. APPLY NOW! Applications are due (electronically) by April 1st.
